## HOUSE RULES FOR VISITORS

Welcome.

We pride ourselves on offering our visitors the highest level of safety and cleanliness. We therefore ask that you follow the rules set out below, which apply throughout the entire premises:

1. You are required to comply with our rules for visitors during your visit to the Forum of Swiss History Schwyz.
2. For security reasons, the Forum of Swiss History Schwyz is under video surveillance.
3. Do not touch the objects on display, damage them or interfere with them in any way. Visitors are liable for all damage they cause.
4. Prams are not allowed inside the exhibition rooms.
5. Unless otherwise indicated, photography for private purposes, without the use of a flash or tripod, is permitted in the permanent exhibition rooms. Photography is not permitted in the temporary exhibition rooms. Filming and videoing is generally prohibited.
6. The Forum of Swiss History Schwyz is a smoke-free zone. It is not permitted to eat or drink in the exhibition areas.
7. Animals are not permitted in the Forum of Swiss History Schwyz, with the exception of guide dogs.
8. Shopping bags, gym bags, briefcases, luggage, backpacks, musical instruments, art portfolios, wet weather gear, umbrellas, heavy coats, jackets, etc. must be deposited in the lockers downstairs. This excludes bags up to A3 size.
9. Items placed in the lockers must be collected before you leave the Forum of Swiss History Schwyz. The lockers are opened and emptied by Museum staff every evening for security reasons.
10. Teachers, group leaders and parents or guardians are responsible for the appropriate behaviour of children and adolescents accompanying them. Shouting and running will not be tolerated in the exhibition rooms. Inappropriate or disruptive behaviour, particularly towards other visitors or towards the staff and representatives of the Forum of Swiss History Schwyz, is prohibited.

The instructions of staff and representatives of the Forum of Swiss History Schwyz must be obeyed. Violations of the rules may result in visitors being asked to leave the Museum, or in prosecution or claims for damages. If you are asked to leave, the entrance fee will not be refunded. Thank you for your understanding. We hope you enjoy your visit.
