

«School trip to the museum!»

Important information for teachers

Welcome to the Forum of Swiss history at Schwyz! We are delighted that you and your pupils intend to visit our museum. Please observe the following guidelines:

Before you visit the exhibition

- The accompanying teacher should report to the Welcome Desk no later than 5 minutes before the tour is due to start. In the meantime, the class should wait outside at the entrance of the museum.
- Bags and backpacks shall be left in a locked room in the basement before the exhibition visit.
- Writing materials may be taken into the exhibition.
- The toilets are located on the basement floor.
- In good weather, it is possible to picnic on the square in front of the museum (Hofmatt). No picnics can be taken in the museum itself.

In the exhibition

- The accompanying teacher is responsible for the behaviour of his/her pupils.
- No flash photography permitted in the permanent exhibition. Photography is not allowed in the temporary exhibition.
- Food and drink cannot be taken into the exhibition.

Booking of guided tours

- Guided tours are possible from Tuesday to Sunday from 10am to 5pm. Outside opening hours, guided tours are available on request and at an extra charge.
- Guided tours are free of charge for school classes from Switzerland.
- Independent exhibition tours can take place from Tuesday to Sunday, during the museum's opening hours.
- Guided tours and non-guided group visits can be booked at the Reservation Desk by e-mail or phone call.
- Guided tours may be cancelled in writing free of charge up to 4 days before the date of the tour. Tours that are cancelled with less than 4 days' notice are subject to a cancellation fee of CHF 80.-.
